

GENERAL INFO



- Open Classes will begin late in the afternoon on Friday. However, if ASH receives a large number of
 routine registrations, Performance Showcase can begin as early as 7:00 am on Friday and in some
 select cities on Thursday. Once capacity is reached, studios who register after capacity has been
 reached may be given the option to perform some or all of their routines on Thursday.
- The Closing Show will generally begin around 1:00 pm on Sunday. We advise planning for the event to end by 4:00 pm on Sunday

SCHEDULE:

- <u>Schedules</u> All Event Schedules, Performance Showcase Schedules, and Welcome Packets will be released exactly 10 calendar days prior to the event by the end of the business day. No information will be available prior to the release of that information. Please do not contact ASH before then about scheduling information.
- <u>Performance Showcase</u> Performance Showcase begins as early as 7:00 am on Friday and in some select cities on Thursday. Once capacity is reached, studios who register after capacity has been reached may be given the option to perform some or all of their routines on Thursday. The exact start and end times of the Performance Showcase will be available on the Performance Showcase Schedule released 10 days prior to the event.
- <u>Open Classes</u> Open Classes are open to all ages 7 and above. Open Classes begin late in the afternoon on Friday. The exact start time of the Open Classes will be available on the Event Schedule released 10 days prior to the event. Routines scheduled during Open Classes or theCOMPANY Intensive rehearsals cannot be changed in order to attend those classes or rehearsals.
- <u>Convention Classes</u> The Welcome Show begins at 7:30am on Saturday and classes begin immediately after the Welcome Show ends at 8:00am.
- <u>Closing Show</u> The Closing Show begins on Sunday afternoon. Though the exact time varies between each event, . The start time of the Closing Show will be available on the Event Schedule released 10 days prior to the event.

THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- ASH accepts registrations under a studio name as well as "Independent". When registering as an Independent, type "Independent" when asked to provide a studio name.
- In order to attend, students must be registered for the convention, but are not required to register routines for the Performance Showcase.
- Dancers that attend a studio, but are attending ASH without the studio, must have the studio complete their registration under the studio account prior to the event.
- We suggest registering as soon as possible due to limited space. Once capacity is reached, registrations will no longer be accepted.
- Wristbands must be worn during all classes and cannot be transferred.
- Observers do not need to register and Observer bands can only be purchased at the event. Observers may NOT be studio owners, teachers, or dancers and are only eligible to register with participating dancers. Observers are not permitted to observe Teacher Classes or Scholarship Auditions.
- It is strongly urged that you make your hotel reservations well in advance to avoid a sell-out. Please visit the city page of the event you are attending where you will find all hotel information. If calling the hotel, please be sure to mention ASH Productions when you make your reservations to receive the discounted room rate.

CONVENTION *REQUIRED



Students must be registered for the convention in order to register routines for the Performance Showcase

LEVELS:

- There are 4 levels of convention classes:
 - Mini Movers : Ages 3-7 (2 shortened days only)
 - Artists In Training : Ages 7-11
 - Intermediate : Ages 12-14
 - Advanced : Ages 15+
- All ages are determined as of January 1st, 2025.
- Studio Owners/Directors may place their students in the level they feel is appropriate to their student's skill level, even if it is different than their age. However, if a student changes levels, they MUST participate in the Scholarship Audition in the level that the student was changed to. For instance, if a student moves from the Intermediate level to the Advanced level, they must audition in the Advanced level. Students ages 21 and up are not eligible to audition for scholarships.
- Each student is allowed one level change per event (if space permits) which must occur by the end of the 2nd class on the first full day of convention classes. Visit the Registration Booth or Merchandise Booth to exchange your wristband.
- At some events where convention class space is limited, ASH will adjust the Age Levels of Convention Classes in order to provide a safe dance environment. Age levels are always listed in the Welcome Packet as well as the Event Schedule when those are released 10 days prior to the event.

SCHOLARSHIP AUDITION:

- To audition for scholarships, dancers must attend the Audition Combo class and the Scholarship Audition listed on the schedule.
- If a student changes levels, they MUST participate in the Scholarship Audition in the level that the student was changed to. For instance, if a student moves from the Intermediate level to the Advanced level, they must audition in the Advanced level.
- Students ages 21 and up are not eligible to audition for scholarships.

THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- While students are eligible to receive multiple scholarships if they attend multiple events, each scholarship may only be used once per season. (Example: Jane Doe attended 3 events in the same season and received the ASH Apprentice scholarship at one event, and ASH Apprentice Runner Up at each of the other two events. Only one ASH Apprentice Runner Up may be used the following season.)
- Scholarships received in the 23/24 Season are the ONLY scholarships eligible for application in the 24/25 Season.
- Scholarships are calculated based on the Regular Rate, NOT the Early Bird Rate.
- Photography and Videography at ASH Productions events are STRICTLY PROHIBITED! Photos and Videos will be available for purchase at www.ASHPhotoVideo.com



MINI MOVERS

An introduction to the dance convention experience, Mini Movers is designed for Ages 3-7 and includes complimentary ASH swag, and one complimentary Observer band (for a parent/guardian) that can be used for Mini Movers classes only and does not grant Observer access to any other ballroom. In select cities, all Mini Movers perform at the start of the Showcase on Saturday on the ASH stage!

Mini Movers can be as young as 3 years old and as old as 7 years old. 7 year olds can either register for the Mini Movers or Artists in Training. Studio Owners have discretion as to which age level is most appropriate for their student.

THECOMPANY INTENSIVE ON TOUR

theCompany Intensive on Tour was born out of theCompany Intensive at Nationals. Working closely with ASH Faculty Choreographers in a rehearsal setting is a valuable opportunity for growth. All registered dancers that attend the specified open class are eligible to be selected to work with an ASH Faculty member to learn an original piece that will be performing in the Closing Show. Please check the event schedule for exact class information. If selected, dancers must attend rehearsals on Friday evening, Saturday mid-morning and Sunday morning before convention classes begin.

All dancers chosen to perform must purchase the exclusive piece of theCompany Intensive Merchandise only available to those selected for theCompany Intensive piece by the Sunday morning tech rehearsal. This exclusive piece of Merchandise is available at the Merchandise Booth.

If a routine is scheduled for the Performance Showcase on Friday night during Open Classes/ theCompany Intensive On Tour rehearsal, routines will NOT be rescheduled.

Teachers, Studio Representatives, and observers may NOT be in the ballroom during rehearsals.

Costumes:

- GIRLS: Please bring a pair of black leggings or sweat pants (no patterns, but ASH logos are okay) and a black top (t-shirt, tank top or crop top).
- BOYS: Please bring a pair of black sweats (no patterns, but ASH logos are okay) and a black top (t-shirt or tank top).

PERFORMANCE SHOWCASE

Performance Showcase can begin as early as 7:00 am on Friday and in some select cities on Thursday. Once capacity is reached, studios who register after capacity has been reached may be given the option to perform some or all of their routines on Thursday.

How is ASH's Performance Showcase Different From a Competition?

The Performance Showcase is an opportunity for dancers to perform their pieces in a supportive and noncompetitive environment. Each performance will be critiqued by the ASH faculty and awards will be given, however, the performances are not scored. Awards are decided by a consensus opinion of the judges.

Things to remember:

The Performance Showcase will be held ALL DAY on Friday, in the afternoon on Saturday and sometimes on Sunday when necessary to accommodate all registered routines.

- To participate in the Performance Showcase, dancers must be registered for the convention.
- Because the Performance Showcase is not a competition, there are no age categories or style categories.
- There will be strict adherence to the Performance Showcase program order. Please be ready to perform when scheduled. Keep in mind that routines which do not perform at their scheduled Performance Showcase time may be ineligible to receive Performance Showcase Awards.
- Each registered dancer may register up to 2 solos for 23/24 Season.
- The "style" of each routine is only for reference for our Media and Lighting teams. Because the Performance Showcase is not a competition, the "style" is not a category and will not be listed anywhere except your online registration account and seen only by our Media and Lighting teams.
- Registration for the Performance Showcase is on a first come, first serve basis. Due to time restraints, once maximum capacity is reached, we will no longer accept Performance Showcase routine registrations. In select cities, studios who register after capacity has been reached may be given the option to perform some or all of their routines on Thursday.
- Dancers may perform solos and duets/trios in the Performance Showcase without a Teacher registered.
- In order to perform a group routine (4+ dancers) in the Performance Showcase, a Teacher or Studio Director must be registered for convention.
- Independent dancers may participate in the Performance Showcase.
- All routines must be appropriate for family viewing.
- Teachers may not coach dancers during performance.
- Changes to any routine must be made by the "Registration Deadline" listed on the specific city page.
- All performers must be students. No Teachers or Professional Dancers.

- If a minimum number of entries is not reached, ASH Productions reserves the right to cancel the Performance Showcase. In the event of a cancellation, ASH Productions will issue a full refund for Performance Showcase fees only.
- Awards received when a dancer is registered with a studio are not valid when registering as an independent or with another studio.



Due to extraordinarily high demand, if a studio registers at least 15 students and 10 routines for an event, then alters that registration after the Early Bird Discount Deadline to fall below 15 students and 10 routines or cancels the registration entirely, the following restrictions will apply to any future registration:

- The online account will be suspended and the studio must email the ASH Office to register.
- A required 50% deposit must be made upon registration.
- Any registration must be paid in full 2 weeks prior to the Early Bird Discount Deadline.

The ASH Stage & Props:

- Props are allowed. However, you must enter the prop information when registering the routine.
- Loading docks are not available in most cities. Props must be able to be loaded through the front entrance of the venue
- The following items may NOT be used in routines: paint, liquid, glass, fire, live animals, confetti, powder, and glitter.
- Props may not be larger than 8 feet tall.
- Prop setup and take down must not exceed 2 minutes for both setup and take down combined. If 2 minutes is exceeded, the routine will not be eligible for Performance Showcase Awards.
- Props must be carried on and off the stage. ASH Staff or Crew will NOT assist in unloading, moving, assembling, repairing, or dismantling props or any other equipment.
- In most cities, ASH will provide a small area for prop storage. Please visit the registration booth when you arrive at the event to locate prop storage.
- Please leave the stage area clean for the next performers.
- Stage Dimensions 24 feet deep x 48 feet wide. The performance stage size varies based on venue size and configuration and can range from approximately 24'x34' to 24'x48' (stage dimensions may or may not include wing space).

Music:

- All music must be uploaded to your online registration account at least one week prior to the start of the event.
- You can upload music by clicking the green "Media Manager" button for your event. Only MP3 files are accepted. Once uploaded, you can preview all music!
- Uploaded music must match the timestamp you entered when registering a routine. If the music exceeds the time entered and also exceeds the time limits listed in the table above, you will be charged according to the extended time rates listed in the table above for each dancer in the routine and become ineligible for Performance Showcase Awards.
- Beginning in the 24/25 Season, any registration with music not uploaded at least one week prior to the start of the event will have a \$50 late fee per routine without music added to their account which must be paid for in order to pick up your registration packet at the event.
- Please bring a backup USB of all music to the event. Only a USB will be accepted. ASH will not accept music on an iPhone, iPod, computer, CD, or any other device.

The Performance Showcase is free to watch and open to all family and friends to attend FOR FREE. You may also watch the Performance Showcase LIVE at www.ASHWebcast.com.
